The meat and cheese used in our dishes comes from *Bob the Butcher* in Rhayader, our salad comes from *Altgoch Organics* near St. Harmon (when in season) and all our fresh bread, scones and teacakes come from the local bakers in Llandrindod Wells.

All of our cakes are baked locally by members of the *Wl County Market* in Llandrindod Wells. Our milk comes from the local milkman in Builth Wells.

The rest of our food is sourced through the *Good Food Distributors* in Llandrindod Wells and aims to be Fairtrade, Organic or as free from additives as we can get it! We hope you enjoy it as much as we do!
